Phil Sauvageau was named to the position of chief technology officer (CTO) at Sirius Computer Solutions immediately following the acquisition of MSI Systems Integrators in November 2010.

Prior to the acquisition, Mr. Sauvageau was the chief operating officer (COO) of MSI, and had served on the company's executive leadership team since April 2002. As COO, Mr. Sauvageau's primary responsibilities included overseeing and directing all operational policies, objectives and initiatives. He was responsible for strategic planning, process improvement, margin improvement, and day-to-day management of the leadership teams responsible for Back-Office Operations, Products & Services, Enterprise Solutions, and Customer Support. He had previously been MSI's executive vice president of Products and Services, and held IBM Power (AIX) engineering management positions at MSI after joining the company in October 1995.

Today he oversees all pre- and post-sales services organizations at Sirius for all brands other than Cisco. He also oversees the Client Asset Management group, as well as Sirius' eight Technology Enablement Centers (TECs).
